At Eagleton, we are dedicated to growing the best educators and students in order to help our school and community thrive. A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL ABOUT MASKS:

Another important update is that starting February 28th, masks will no longer be required. The CDC states that masks are one of the most effective ways to stop the spread of COVID, so while they will no longer be required, DPS and CDPHE still strongly recommend wearing one. Each family will need to assess their own risk and make a decision that is best for their family. At Eagleton, each morning, as students enter our doors, staff will offer them a mask to use throughout the day, if they would like. And we will have masks available for any student that requests one.

For this reason, it is important that students do not come to school if they have symptoms. If a student is exhibiting symptoms, they will be sent to the health office and we will call home.
