Note: At this time, their mobile vaccine appointments cannot be scheduled through the Denver Health Appointment Center like the other <u>Denver Health vaccine appointments</u>.

Health Screens and COVID-19 Protocols

In response to increased COVID-19 cases in the City and County of Denver, Eagleton has reinstituted classroom-based health screens for all ECE-5 students. As we enter the cold and flu season, all community members must be more vigilant in order to maintain the health and safety of our students and staff. Please do not send your students to school with any cold or flu symptoms. If your child is a close contact of anyone that has tested positive, notify Eagleton immediately. If your child is a close contact at school, we will notify you immediately. We will not share specific information about staff or students who have tested positive and your information will remain confidential as we complete the required contact tracing protocols.

We will not take temperatures in K-5 classrooms. Only ECE students will have a temperature check at the door, per licensing guidelines. The screening questions that students are asked each day are listed below: How are you feeling today?

- Feeling warm?
- Coughing?
- Hard to breathe?
- Muscle aches and chills?
- Sore throat?
- Runny nose?

- Smell and taste gone?
- Sick to your stomach?
- Is anyone you live with sick?
- Has anyone you live with been tested for COVID recently?

If your student presents any symptom throughout the day you will receive a phone to pick up your student. Your student may return to school when he/she has been symptom free for at least 24 hours without the use of medicine like Advil® or Motrin® (Ibuprofen) or TYLENOL® (Acetaminophen).
